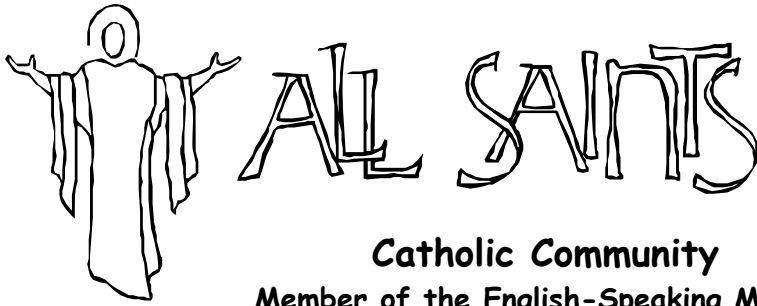

- **Saint Patrick** (c. 387 – 461), the patron saint of Ireland, is one of the world's most popular saints. He was ordained a bishop, and sent to take the Gospel to Ireland in 433. Legend says that he met a chieftain, who tried to kill Patrick. Patrick converted the chieftain after he was unable to move his arm until he became friendly to Patrick. Patrick was preaching the Gospel throughout Ireland, worked miracles, converted thousands and built churches all over the country. He died on March 17, 461. St. Patrick's Day was first celebrated in the US in 1762.
