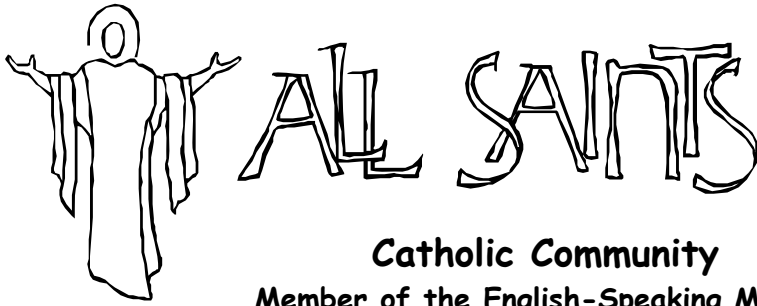

General Intention: That the nations of the earth, through knowledge and mutual respect, may grow in harmony and peace. • **Missionary Intention:** That children and young people may be messengers of the Gospel and that their dignity may always be respected and preserved from all violence and exploitation.

Advent

The new liturgical year begins with the time of Advent, the preparation for Christmas. It's a time of transition – from something old towards something new. • Transitions are always uncertain and demanding times. Times where the old things are no longer valid and where the new things are not yet known. Transitions are giving you a feeling of uncertainty, ambiguity, hesitation. But we are not forced to remain passive; we can make use of times of transition, so that they help us on our way, so that they bear fruit for our lives and for the lives of others. • Advent is one of these times – it prepares a breakthrough from darkness to light, from emptiness to life. Those coming weeks are marked by liturgies with very beautiful biblical texts. They invite us to believe in God who is the lover of life, they invite us to celebrate God's promise of life to us.
