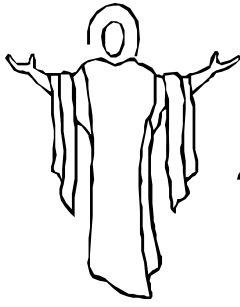

We just started a new year a few days ago. Unlike the "secular" year, the Liturgical Year of the Catholic Church begins with Advent in November/December and is organized around the life and ministry of Jesus. Major "events" of the Church Year are Advent, Christmas and Christmastide, Epiphany of the Lord, Lent, Holy Week, Easter, Pentecost, with those times not included in the above periods counted as "Ordinary Time". In terms of readings we have currently Year A in the *Revised Common Lectionary*. The Liturgical year in the Anglican Church is in most respects identical to and that in the Eastern Orthodox Church is in many ways similar to the Roman Catholic year. The majority of Orthodox Christians (Russians, in particular) follow the Julian Calendar, with a thirteen-day difference between the dates of the Julian and Gregorian (our) calendars meaning that Christmas in the Orthodox Church fell this year on January 7.
