The Spirit of discernment favors unity in diversity

Pentecost is full of images: *fire, storm, water* – all symbols of the Holy Spirit. For the young Christian community, this was a confirmation of their faith. The “*proof and evidence*” gave them a joy and energy which could not be confined but needed open space. Pentecost is the birth of the Church: “*Go out and make God’s spirit visible and touchable among your fellow human beings!*” We can do this by loving ourselves, our neighbors, God and even our enemies.

So discernment is necessary – it is a gift to be able to discern the Spirit coming from God. This Spirit helps to avoid simplification, uniformity and indoctrination, and to live unity in diversity – in the Church, in our families, in our states and societies.

What spirit do we see at work: the Spirit that favors unity in diversity or the spirit that favors uniformity? To remain open for discernment is not an easy task. It is easier to rely on prejudices; to judge by generalizing than to be open to change or to adjust oneself to what happens. Discernment starts by saying “*no*” to what has been taught and indoctrinated for centuries. Discernment starts with the courage to speak up against hypocrisy also in our own Church. Discernment starts with the courage to think for yourself and put oneself in the position of others and to speak the language of others so that we can understand each other.

Pentecost did not bring one uniform and standardized language for all, each could hear the others in his or her own language. The new English missal by the International Commission on English in the Liturgy presents one single unique and identical translation for all English speakers of the world. This English translation is very near to the Latin original and it presupposes quite an effort as the prayers are often difficult to pronounce and proclaim correctly. The new English translation is aimed to serve as the translation of reference to many other smaller languages. Discernment of the Spirit of God might have come to a different result: Unity yes, uniformity no!

The Holy Spirit taught Jesus’ friends to speak the language of others so that others can understand. Pentecost is the coronation of Easter, it helps us cope with diversity and it helps us avoid simplifications and uniformity.
