Look up at the sky and count the stars, if you can. Genesis 15:5

We take enormous risks by seeing human beings as things, as objects, not respecting them, exploiting them, humiliating them, abusing them. If priests abuse children and young people, I would like to know where they see God's image in their victims. How can one abuse a human being and still proclaim the good news of God's love for his creation? How can you abuse and not see God's image in the one you abuse? This is not a phenomenon for priests alone, abuse is going on in all parts of our society – it is just all the more shocking if it is done by a priest. By a priest who proclaims that we are created, that we are God's image. So not taking into account God's love for us, forgetting that all of us are God's image is a dead end road.
