The John F. Kennedy School celebrates its 50th Anniversary.

The John F. Kennedy School was established in 1960 under the name "German-American Community School" as a public school offering integrated, bilingual education for both German and American pupils, to foster cultural exchange between children of West Berlin and children from U.S. Armed Forces families. The school received its current name in December 1963, in honor of U.S. President Kennedy shortly after his assassination. After German reunification in 1990 and the withdrawal of the Allied forces, the mission of the school was redefined. Originally the focus was primarily on the reconciliation after the Second World War; today, the school is a model for bilingual schools in Europe. With over 1700 German, American, and other international students from grades K through 13, the JFKS combines the strengths of both the German and American educational traditions.

Three years junior of All Saints, JFKS looks back to five decades of successful schooling and German-American friendship with a special education concept, a strong, thriving school community and plenty of energy for the future.
