We are the descendants of the ten lepers

(Luke 17:11-19)

Jesus heals the ten lepers. Usually in the text, the one leper who comes back grateful to Jesus is the only who has been truly healed. The other nine lepers are unthankful and reject Jesus. The presentation of this story does not clearly reflect the intention of Jesus. Why? Because Jesus does not forsake others – he does not turn anyone away.

The story of the ten lepers is not about the one single follower of Jesus and the nine renegades. They have all been touched and healed. However, each reacts to the healing in his or her personal way. Jesus copes with the lepers' rejection without renouncing them. And it is our task to follow in His footsteps – we, the followers of Jesus, are the descendants of the ten lepers.
