December 26, 2010 The Holy Family

Sirach 3:2-7, 12-14 • Psalm 128:1-5 • Colossians 3:12-21 • Matthew 2:13-15, 19-23

Our devotion to the Holy Family naturally grows out of a love for Jesus and his family. Pope Benedict XV inserted the Feast of the Holy Family on October 26, 1921 into the Latin Rite general calendar. Today we celebrate the Feast on the Sunday between Christmas and New Year's Day. The Feast of the Holy Family is not just about the Holy Family, but about our own families too. The main purpose of the Feast is to present the Holy Family as the model for all Christian families. Our family life becomes sanctified when we live the life of the Church within our homes. St. John Chrysostom urged all Christians to make each home a "family church," and in doing so, we sanctify the family. The best way is by making Christ and his Church the center of family and individual life. Ways to do this include: reading scripture regularly, praying daily, attending Mass at least on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation, imitating the actions of the Holy Family, all done together as a family unit.
