Holy Father's prayer intentions for March 2011 • General Intention: That the nations of Latin America may walk in fidelity to the Gospel and be bountiful in social justice and peace. • Missionary Intention: That the Holy Spirit may give light and strength to the Christian communities and the faithful who are persecuted or discriminated against because of the Gospel.

Saint Thomas Aquinas is the Church's greatest theologian and philosopher. He was born in Aquino, Italy, in 1225 and died in Fossanova on March 7, 1274. He was the founder of natural theology which is based on reason and ordinary experience. His influence on Western thought is considerable, and much of modern philosophy was conceived as a reaction against, or as an agreement with his ideas, particularly in the areas of ethics, political theory and natural law (whose content is set by nature and uses reason to analyze human nature and deduce binding rules of moral behavior). His most fundamental works are "Summa theologica" and "Summa contra gentiles". Due to his achievements in philosophy he is often called Doctor Angelicus, Doctor Communis or Doctor Universalis. He is not only the patron saint of those called Thomas but also of students and universities. Pope Saint Pius X said: "The capital theses in the philosophy of St. Thomas are ... the foundations upon which the whole science of natural and divine things is based."
