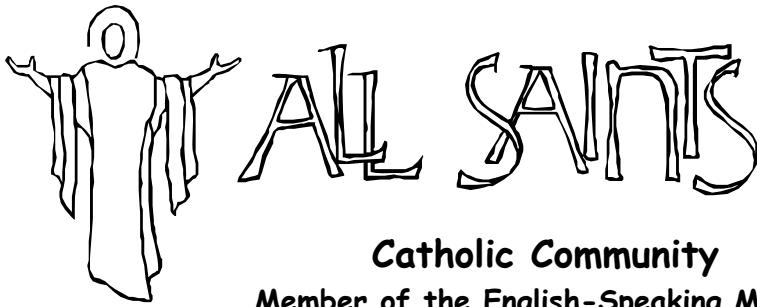

Come out from the Narrowness of your Grave (John 11)

In the gospel we heard last Sunday, Jesus says, "*Lazarus, come out! (Jn 11) Come out from the narrowness of your grave. Come out! You no longer are subject to the conditions of a dead body. Something new can begin for you!*" And in the first reading we heard: "*I am now going to open your graves; I shall raise you from your graves, my people, I will put my Spirit in you, and you will live. I, the Lord, have spoken!*" (Ez 37).

Resurrection is not something in the far future, resurrection begins in the here and now. But it assumes trust in God, the future, in others and in ourselves. Trust in spite of violence, brutality, greed and the worldly stench which sometimes cannot be avoided.

Every day, we have the chance to unbind the ties of death, to break the rigor mortis of our lives and to lead a life in the spirit of Jesus that is marked by the power of love for God, our friends, our enemies and ourselves.
