Christ's resurrection is the basis of our belief

Although the various Christian Churches place different emphasis on the major religious feasts throughout the liturgical year, Easter, the feast of the Resurrection of our Lord, is one of the most important events in all of the Christian Churches. Christ's resurrection is the foundation of our Christian belief and the strongest argumentation for Christ's teaching. Our brothers and sisters in the Orthodox Churches attribute special attention to Easter which is reflected in the length of their services. In the Russian Orthodox Church, an expression of their appreciation of Christ's resurrection is the special form of greeting they use at Easter: "Christ has resurrected!" which is answered by, "Indeed, He has resurrected!" Even the Russian word for Sunday (voskresenie) stems from "resurrected" (voskres), being the most emphatic all-year reminder of the foundation of Christian belief.
