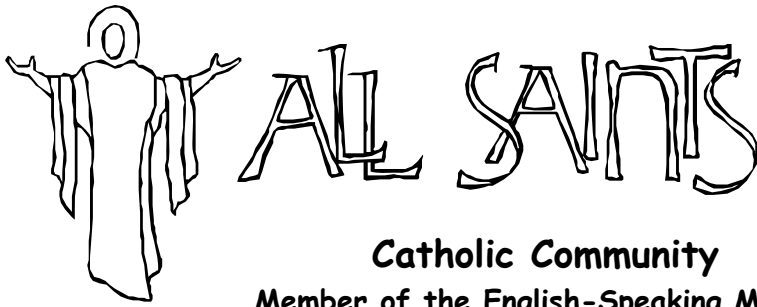

Acts 2:42-47 • Psalm 118:2-4, 13-15, 22-24 • 1 Peter 1:3-9 • John 20:19-31

Easter is the time when we turn our life around.

If we fail to do so, we will only look at an empty tomb and at death; the risen Lord will not reach us and we will fail to discover a new life. Mary Magdalene turns at the tomb and discovers life. Death no longer has power over her heart and mind: she is set free. Let us turn our eyes away from the empty tomb, let us turn around and meet the living Jesus and a new life. It does not make any sense to scrutinize the stone – it will never tell us anything about life. But if we do turn around, there is no stone but Jesus waiting for us with new life.

This is the message of Easter.
