Holy Father's prayer intentions for June 2011

"If you are asked about your Christian hope, always be ready to explain it" (1 Peter 3:15).

If we are attentive to see signs and traces of His love, we need not worry about how to explain our faith to others; we can speak about how it lives in us, how it strengthens and encourages us, and how it consoles us without needing to quote dogmas or truths written in books.

People who know us may see how our faith strengthens us and, as a result, they may express interest in our faith. Let us transmit God's love for us to those who need a sign of encouragement in their lives: "So I pray that God, who gives you hope, will keep you happy and full of peace as you believe in him. May you overflow with hope through the power of the Holy Spirit." (Rom 15:13)
