## "Are you envious because I am generous?" (Mt 20, 15)

**T**he logic of human justice requires that those who work a full day, receive a full day's wage, and those who work one hour, receive one hour's pay.

It is not so in the kingdom of God. Those who have labored in the ways of righteousness from early morning receive their full reward – that is OK for us. But prostitutes, tax collectors and sinners who arrive at the eleventh hour receive no less – they also receive their full reward.

This is what the prophet Isaiah suggests when he says: "My thoughts are not your thoughts and my ways are not your ways" (Is 55, 8).

The Church is the servant of the kingdom of God, and the Church is bound by the laws of the kingdom, not by the way human law binds people. We are commanded to invite to supper not only those who have earned a place by their long fidelity – but all those as well who have "just arrived at the gate". The host in the gospel asks, "I am free to do as I please ... am I not? Or are you envious because I am generous?"

I would like to pray that the Church not only invites the good and the respectable and the pious and the just, - this would be human justice. I would like to pray that our Church is open to practicing God's justice, a justice that cannot be contained by our human thoughts, our human laws and their application. A justice that is not so much the fruit of legalistic thinking but the fruit of an astonishing and unexpected love we are all offered by our loving God who time and again astonishes and surprises us with his overwhelming generosity.
