Exodus 22:20-26; Psalm 18:2-4, 47, 51; 1 Thessalonians 1:5-10; Matthew 22:34-40

There is a story about a man who runs out to meet a monk who is passing by the village. 'Give me the stone,' he cries, 'the precious stone.' The monk says, 'What stone are you talking about?' The man says, 'Last night God appeared to me in a dream and said, "A monk will be passing by the village at noon tomorrow, and if he gives you a rock that he is carrying with him, you will be the richest man in the country." So give me the stone!'
