The European Peace Meeting of Taizé in Berlin (Dec 28, 2011 – Jan 1, 2012)

The Taizé Community – a pilgrimage of trust

The ecumenical Taizé community was founded by Brother Roger Schutz in Burgundy, France in 1940. The community is composed of brothers from over 25 countries, Catholics and Protestants who seek to live in reconciliation and peace. Over the years, young adults from every continent have been coming to Taizé to take part in weekly meetings in increasing numbers.

The Taizé Community has been holding annual youth conventions in Europe for over 33 years. In recent years, tens of thousands of young adults from eastern and western European countries have participated on this event. The 34th European Meeting will be held in Berlin from December 28, 2011 to January 1, 2012. This event is being sponsored by the Protestant and Catholic churches and the Berlin Senate. The youth who participate in the annual convention seek to strengthen the understanding between Christians of different traditions and nations and deepening their Christian faith and social engagement.

We need host families!

Please consider hosting one or more young people in your home during the five days of the meeting. The participants, ranging from age 17 to 35, will bring camping mats and sleeping-bags with them and can easily sleep on the floor. They only need a simple breakfast and will be busy participating in the program during the day. After the evening prayer at the convention center, they will return to their host families around 10 pm. On January 1st, there will be time to share lunch with your guest. The local preparation teams in each district will organize the distribution of guests to their hosts and will contact with you in early December at the latest.
