Holy father's Prayer Intentions for November 2011

General Intention: That the Eastern Catholic Churches and their venerable traditions may be known and esteemed as a spiritual treasure for the whole Church.

Missionary Intention: Justice and Reconciliation in Africa. That the African continent may find strength in Christ to pursue justice and reconciliation as set forth by the second Synod of African Bishops.

We probably all know situations when we have to choose between keeping the rules or putting the priority on someone's well-being. The Gospel (Mt 22, 34-40) shows us how to react in such situations. Jesus puts an emphasis on the commandment 'Love thy neighbor'. Rules that exclude love of our neighbors imprison humanity. The love of law may be a praiseworthy quality, but we can only truly love another human being. The love of law is of extreme importance for an orderly society, but it must never go as far as to cause another human being to fail.

In this respect, Christians are invited to cast a critical eye on the events happening in our nations, economies and Church. How do our nations, economies and Church treat people? How do they treat those who are different because of their culture, traditions, religious affiliation or orientation? God shows us in Jesus Christ how far love can go. Jesus dies on the cross; but in his death out of love for humankind lies the germ of resurrection. God became a human being, and by becoming a human being, God unambiguously put his love above justice, more precisely: Love is the justice of God. We celebrate God's justice every Sunday in the Eucharist.
