November 27, 2011, First Sunday of Advent

Isaiah 63:16-17, 19; 64:2-7 Psalm 80:2-3, 15-16, 18-19; 1 Corinthians 1:3-9; Mark 13:33-37

The first Christian communities were attractive for many reasons. People often converted to this new religion because of the importance given to each individual. This importance was given to each individual of the community when he or she committed themselves to imitating the death and rising of Jesus. They themselves became "other Christs", they became equal members of the communities to which they belonged.

Long before Jesus, the classic Hebrew prophets also condemned anyone who treated others with disdain. And they criticized leaders – especially political and religious ones. Let us take the passage of Ezekiel (Ez 34, 11-12, 15-17). We hear about people crushed down by unfeeling leaders. To them the prophet promises that one day Yahweh will break into their oppressed lives, he promises that one day Yahweh actually will "shepherd" them: "I will look for my sheep and take care of them myself, just as a shepherd looks for lost sheep. I promise to take care of them and keep them safe, to look for those that are lost and bring back the ones that wander off, to bandage those that are hurt and protect the ones that are weak. Because I am a shepherd who does what is right."
