God constantly leads us beyond the limits that faith imposes

Luke tells us at the beginning of his gospel who Mary's child is, who the child will be (Luke 1:26-38). But the historical Mary might not have discovered these things until many years later when she reflected on the implications of her son's death and resurrection: during his life on earth, Jesus probably was a mystery to his own mother.

And here Mary becomes a model for us: I am sure, that - like all of us - Mary had to live a lifetime in a faith where she constantly discovered the different directions into which God was leading her. Over and over again Mary had to learn how God was part of her life. I am sure that Mary never had imagined what God had in mind for her before it actually began to unfold.

For Luke, the perfect disciple is the man or woman who first hears God's word, then carries it out. I presume God's word will come for most of us not in a spectacular annunciation by an angel, but in the ways God enters our everyday lives. And here we have to open our eyes and ears to perceive him in our lives, in the lives of the others. Amen.
