The talent

Excerpt from Fr Ludger's sermon

In the parable one servant obtained five talents, the second two talents and the third only one talent from their master who was about to go for a journey.

The talent is a Greek weight and is about 41 kilograms. So the person, who obtained one talent, received 41 kilograms of silver coins. In today's terms this means that he obtained about 500,000 Euros. And he did nothing with his 500,000 Euros!

To illustrate these facts, it is better to say: one kilogram of silver coins is like an ability. So he had 41 abilities: He could tell jokes, was able to swim, listen, walk, speak, run, read, write, gifted to be a good friend, able to pray, be a good brother, become a craftsman, a sailor, and so on

And with his 500,000 Euros, with his 41 kilograms of gifts he did nothing!

This is pretty bad!

Maybe it is really necessary to say to people: You are someone! Your are gifted! Yes, you can do something. Never bury yourself in a hole!
