WHO LIVES THE TRUTH, COMES TO THE LIGHT

Nicodemus has a divided heart. Although he is fascinated by the person of Jesus and his message, there are many unanswered questions in his heart. He seeks clarity; he wants to understand the truth of behind this man. Jesus does not give him a book to read or a catechism to study. He first puts him starkly before the hard reality of the cross. "The son of man (Jesus himself) has to be lifted up..." and then, in two short sentences, he describes two ways of living: one that leads deeper into darkness, the other that leads to the light. What blocks us on the way to the light are "evil deeds". When I do something wrong, I do not want it to be seen, I hide. When they had taken the forbidden fruit, Adam and Eve hid. Children try to cover up when they have done something wrong. Political parties employ "spin doctors" to cover up unpopular decisions and make them look nice. Companies cover up their wrong-doing by publicity campaigns. Fishy dealings and contracts that are not above board are kept secret.

What is there in my life that I do not want to be known? What blocks me on my road to the light, to the Lord? Jesus proposed Nicodemus a way to get nearer to the light: "Live the truth". Do always what you know to be true and right. Live according to your conscience, even in the small decisions of every day. You may just watch a shallow show on TV and the idea crosses your mind that your aunt is just out of hospital and would enjoy a call... Live the truth, follow the appeal of this moment: now, not tomorrow. You are just about to buy a 3-Euro T-shirt, when you realize that at such a price the worker who sewed it cannot have been paid a fair salary. Buy a "Fair Trade" product instead because the producer has paid his workers a fair salary. Act always according to the voice of conscience. Jesus promises Nicodemus and us that we will get nearer to the light, nearer to God, when we eliminate from our lives whatever is not open and transparent and live always consequently the truth, do what we know to be true and just.
