# Holy Father's Prayer intentions for April 2012

*General Intention*: Vocations. That many young people may hear the call of Christ and follow him in the priesthood and religious life.

*Missionary Intention*: Christ, Hope for Africans. That the risen Christ may be a sign of certain hope for the men and women of the African continent.

## If the grain of wheat dies, it bears much fruit...

The death of a loved person can be devastating. Jesus offers us a completely different vision of death, his own death and ours, in the image of the grain of wheat that has to be sown in the ground and die in order to produce a hundredfold harvest. For Jesus, death is part of a larger picture, just one scene in the drama of life. Dying to make room for a new life seems the law of nature. If the dinosaurs had not died out, the mammals, including the human race, would not have had a chance to develop. If the elder generation does not step aside, the younger has no chance to develop their own ideas and possibilities.

The Church has experienced this law of life through death throughout its history. "The blood of martyrs is the seed of new Christians..." was a saying in the early Church. The missionaries in Uganda had to leave a small fragile Christian community on their own and flee because of political troubles. When they returned some years later it had grown tenfold. Dying to come to new life is also the law of our spiritual growth. The 6-year-old has to stop believing in Santa Claus to discover the love of his parents in their gifts. Teenagers have to leave behind much of socialized religion to build their personal relationship with God. Sometimes God takes away the felt experience of his presence in prayer to lead us into the darkness of deeper faith, as Mother Theresa experienced in the last decades of her life.

If we refuse to let go, we get stuck in rigid lifeless pattern of thinking, praying and living. Jesus invites us to "embrace" the cross in whatever form it comes and promises that more abundant life and greater fruitfulness will follow.
