Paul invites us to discover the risen Jesus in our lives

The vast majority of our Sacred Scriptures were composed years, even centuries after the events took place. The interval between the events and the biblical text provided their authors with something very valuable: the ability to interpret those events through the lens of later events and of later experiences. 50 years after John the Baptist's public appearance, **Luke** wants his readers to reflect on the significance of his ministry: John the Baptist not only had a great impact on his contemporaries, he also played an important role in the decision of Jesus to go public.

Before mass, in the sacristy, I sometimes tell the altar servers: "Let's go, if you don't make a move, mass cannot start." In the same way, Luke tells us: "If John hadn't made **his** move, Jesus wouldn't have made **his**."

Luke uses a quotation from Isaiah to anticipate Jesus' coming: "In the desert someone is shouting, 'Get the road ready for the Lord! Make a straight path for him." What John had declared in the context of his own religious community is re-interpreted by Luke in a Christian context. Only years after John's original proclamation did the followers of Jesus find this deeper significance in John's words. If this is the case with John and what he did and said, the events of our everyday lives may also have a deeper meaning – as long as we know how to interpret them.

That's what Paul says in **Philippians** (1:4-6, 8-11): *I pray that your love will keep on growing and that you will fully know and understand how to make the right choices. Then you will still be pure and innocent when Christ returns. And until that day, Jesus Christ will keep you busy doing good deeds that bring glory and praise to God. Paul wants his community to have experiences of the risen Jesus in their lives. We, too, can have experiences of the risen Christ in our everyday lives: every time we feel that something hopeless turns into good, if we receive something without "deserving" it, if we are loved or can share love. Let us discover the risen Lord in our lives, in the lives of others and in our world.*
