1 Samuel 1:20-22, 24-28 Psalm 84: 2-3, 5-6, 9-10 1 John 3:1-2, 21-24 Luke 2:41-52

A good disciple first hears God's word and then carries it out.

The evangelists, as all writers, have their favorite topics which they repeat time and again. Luke wants his readers to be good disciples of Jesus – this is his favorite topic. He believes that there is one basic way to accomplish this. For him, perfect followers of Jesus commit themselves to just two things: they first hear God's word, then carry it out.

The evangelist puts his theme, his favorite topic into the mouth of Elizabeth. Greeting Mary, Elizabeth states: "Blessed are you who believed that what was spoken to you by the Lord would be fulfilled" (Luke 1:39-45). Even readers who are not so well acquainted with Luke's gospel quickly realize one thing: Jesus' mother is Luke's very best example of the good disciple. She assured Gabriel, "Let it be done to me according to God's word." Later Luke mentions, "She stored up these words in her heart." There's no doubt about Luke's theme and the one who exemplifies it: to be a good disciple is to listen to the word of God and act accordingly. Mary is the best example for this.

Anyone who studies and lives by the Scripture understands that both God's will and God's word are "moving objects" which means that at a certain time we know what God wants or at a certain time we listen to God's word. But at a different moment, what we know, what we hear, what we read can be something very different. To know what God wants, to listen to God's word isn't something that happens once in a lifetime. Perceiving God's will and word is a lifetime process. Those who give themselves over to God's will and word are committing themselves to taking that will and word beyond their own limits. No matter how convinced we are that we exactly know what God tells us and what road God wants us to take in life, we are constantly discovering new words and new directions.

I presume Mary did not exactly know where God was leading her. I presume Mary did not perceive the depth of God's word at the beginning of her discipleship. Now there is a splendid occasion to reflect on how we have perceived God's will and word which have been <u>changing</u> during our discipleship.
