The family

Excerpt from the Dec 30 Mass sermon

The church endorses the family of Joseph, Mary and Jesus as an ideal family model. If we look more closely at their family life, it is not entirely idyllic and romantic. There were external threats and internal doubts in the beginning. The reality of modern family life is not different and is likewise difficult. Broken families, single parenthood, absentee fathers and infidelity are undeniable common facts that cannot be solved by prayerful wishes. Despite these complexities, there is a need to reflect on the spirituality of family life and not just mainly focus on its function or lack thereof in society.

Are we concerned of our family members? This is not only the responsibility of parents but of each member of the family. A family is a conjugal community. Each one has a role for its existence and sustenance. How do we show concern to our parents and siblings aside from greeting them during the holidays and on their birthdays or anniversaries?

Are we obedient to our parents? It has never been easy to be obedient. By nature, we like to do what we want. We value freedom and self-determination. When we were children, we obeyed our parents because we regarded them as authority figures. Our attitude towards authorities comes from our experience with our parents. Our disposition towards God and His commandments reflects how we respect and value human authority.

God came to the world and entered into a human family. Through His incarnation, we learn how to live in a divine family as exemplified by the divine Trinity: God the Father, God the Son and the Holy Spirit. May this model of communion enrich and strengthen our family life.
