#### What Jesus left out

The ordinary people in Greece are hard up these days. With hard work and the help of friends many had managed to build themselves a small house. In time of need we will have at least a roof over our heads, so they thought. To repay a huge national debt, the government is now forced to put new taxes on everything, including houses. The jobless cannot pay them and lose their homes. Last year over 3000 people committed suicide.

The people Jesus addressed in the synagogue of Nazareth were in a similar situation. They were poor peasants and burdened with taxes from all sides. King Herod Antipas wanted their money to build two new cities: Tiberias and Sapphora. The Roman Governor needed money to pay his occupation army. The temple tax went to the priests in Jerusalem. If you did not pay your taxes you were sent to prison or worse.

Jesus in his first speech announced a "year of the Lord's favor", a jubilee year as described in the book of Leviticus in chapter 25. Every 50 years all debts were cancelled, those who had sold their land and got enslaved because they could not pay their debts were set free. Jesus announced a social revolution that would give everybody a new chance. Good news, indeed, especially for the poor!

What is **not** said is sometimes as important as what is said. Jesus quoted the beginning of chapter 61 of Isaiah when he announced a "year of the Lord's favor", but he left out the second part of the verse: "and a day of vengeance of our God". He had not come to destroy the wicked and punish the sinners and chase away the hated Roman oppressors, as everybody expected the Messiah to do. His "Abba" let his sun shine on the just and the wicked alike. He too was sent not to condemn, but to save and to give life to all. So his listeners in Nazareth were deeply disappointed and threw him out of town.
