Resurrection

Og Mandino, the bestseller American author of the book "The Greatest Salesman of the World", risked his carrier and reputation as a writer when he published the controversial novel "The Christ Commission". It was a story about an investigation into the authenticity of Christ's resurrection. At the end, he echoed what St. Paul wrote to the Corinthians: "And if Christ has not been raised, our preaching is useless and so is your faith" (1 Cor 15:14).

Indeed, the belief of the resurrection of Christ is a central tenet of our Christian faith. But according to recent surveys, many Christians have difficulties accepting and understanding this article of faith, even if most of them are church-goers and active members in their church community. It is because we live in these modern times where every phenomenon is explained through science and verified by experiments. The occurrence of a resurrection is rare, if not singular.

What is actually the resurrection? Pope Benedict once wrote: "the resurrection is not resuscitation". This means a person is not simply revived and brought back to his old life. He is transformed into a new being just like the risen Christ, whom Mary Magdalene mistakenly recognized as a gardener. Resurrection is also not reincarnation, which is a teaching of Hinduism and Buddhism. Is the belief of the resurrection a myth or fairytale similar to the stories behind the Easter bunny and Easter eggs? There are no easy answers to this fundamental and important question.

Every Christian should ponder upon this central dogma of our faith. Instead of focusing on the historicity or scientific dispute about it, we could move forward by accepting it as a mystery of faith. Recognizing a mystery is not being blind to reason. It is embracing the logic of belief and spirituality.

Resurrection is an invitation to allow God to enter into our lives and perform miracles in us. Let us make room for God, so that He may transform the personal and social tombs within us. Let Him change what is dead and stagnant in our relationships. Let Him revive our forgotten dreams and discarded ideals. Let Him make us optimistic and hopeful, when we seem trapped in despair and crisis.

Easter is considered the feast of all feasts in the Catholic Church. We celebrate the resurrection of our Lord, which is the dramatic climax of His suffering and death. Easter allows us to renew our lives in the spirit of the resurrected Christ.
