An Experience of Mission

When we read the Bible, the important question to not ask: What really did happen? But rather: What does it mean? The Gospel is not a newspaper report; it wants to tell us something new about God. The story of today is not about some fishermen in Galilee catching 153 fish, but about the experience of mission of the early church.

Seven disciples go fishing. 7 is the symbolic figure for perfection and plenitude. The whole church is meant to go "fishing", but not fish, but rather people, as Peter is told when he experienced the first miraculous catch. So all disciples go out on mission: a first attempt organized by themselves ends in failure; when sent out by Jesus, it becomes an overwhelming success.

The disciples had to understand that the church and her mission was not their work, but Jesus' work. Relying only on their own strength, they would not have gone very far. United with Jesus and listening to the inspirations of his Spirit, their mission was abundantly blessed. Jesus had told them: "Without me you can do nothing."

Is there a lesson for us today? Today's situation of the Church resembles the apostles working hard but catching nothing. Churches become emptier, the Church loses influence, religion is ridiculed. Our mission seems a failure.

What is the answer? Should we call in a management consultant firm like McKinsey? Or hire a professional advertising company? Or restructure our parishes? The starting point is maybe to listen attentively to the far away voice from the shore telling us what to do next. We must become so quiet that we can hear it. Do we give time for prayer and silence to be able to hear it when we meet for our parish council?

When Jesus later gives Peter his mission, he does not ask him to do a PhD in theology or in management or communication. No, he simply asked: *Do you love me? Are you going to be near me so you can hear my voice and follow what I say?*
