In things, people and events interrupting our plans we will most notice God entering our lives

We humans constantly work on trying to be in control of our lives. Scheduling almost every minute of our day is of utmost importance, without our datebook or digital organizer we are lost. If we have a destiny in life, it should be one of our own making. There are spiritual authors who encourage us in such a quest, but for a reason quite different from "being in control". "Everyone should at least try to schedule his or her day because it's in those things, people and events which interrupt our plans that we will most notice God entering our lives." The key to understanding such unplanned interruptions is in the gospel passage (John 13:31-33, 34-35). "I give you a new commandment: Love one another. Such as my love has been for you, so must your love be for one another." Nothing does more effectively interfere with order in our lives than the decision to love another person. Deeply loving people quickly discover the "disorder" which takes over when they make such a life-changing choice. No matter their "best laid plans," things rarely work out that way.

Barnabas and Paul do come face to face with opposition to their message in the synagogues: the Jews are not willing to listen to them. Therefore they turn to those who eagerly accept their good news: Gentiles, non-Jews who have no intention of becoming Jewish converts. "On their arrival (in Antioch), they called the congregation together and related all that God had helped them accomplish, and how God had opened the door of faith to the Gentiles." The love with which they approached all people forced them to imitate the love with which God approaches all people.

Only when love interrupts our everyday patterns and plans will anything change for the better. We can trust Jesus that our love of one another will bring about something a lot better than we have now. Jesus promises that we will be known as his disciples by our love of one another.
