Which Way to a Better World? by Fr. Wolfgang Schonecke M.Afr.

With rare exception throughout history the law of the jungle prevails; the weaker is dominated by the stronger power such as Tibet by China, Ukraine by Russia and the developing by the industrialized countries. Ancient Israel was a small, poor country crushed between surrounding superpowers of Egypt and a succession of empires to the East including the Romans. Rarely were they truly free yet throughout their history they kept an unshakeable hope of freedom under a just king, the Messiah.

When John the Baptist announced that the Messiah was among them, expectations ran high. Soon they would be rid of the brutal Roman army and their despotic king and would live in a just and peaceful world.

This message got John the Baptist quickly into prison but when Jesus started his messianic ministry, nothing of what John had announced happened. There was no recruitment of a guerrilla army, no revolt against local kings nor a revolution against landlords. So John and others were deeply disappointed by Jesus who had chosen a different road to change the world into God's kingdom. He invited people, not to fight against oppressors, but to start a new community where all would share their resources, where people would care for the sick and handicapped; where authority would not mean domination but service. A world of freedom and justice would not fall from heaven, but would be built by us with God's help.

Are we not often disappointed by God? We all long for a just and peaceful world but God does not intervene. He invites us to contribute for a better world, maybe by changing our consumer habits, by sharing with others and by challenging politicians to put the common good above personal interests. Africa's great hero, Nelson Mandela, is an encouraging example. Faced with the most unjust system of apartheid, he had a vision of a free South Africa, where people of all races could live in peace and dignity. He fought and suffered for his ideal and changed the world for the better. What is my contribution to a more just and peaceful world?
