# Easter, the feast of life

#### 1<sup>st</sup> – For us, the empty tomb is a reason to hope

Yes, we celebrate Christ's resurrection, we celebrate the new life, but this Easter mystery does not deny the reality of suffering and pain of Holy Friday. No, this Easter Mystery proclaims reason for hope in our human condition — our human condition marked by illness, suffering, dying and death. The empty tomb of Christ trumpets the ultimate *Alleluia*. The empty tomb makes palpable and visible Christ's message that love, compassion, generosity, humility and selflessness will ultimately triumph over hatred, bigotry, prejudice, despair, greed and death. Sometimes in our lives, we find ourselves in difficult and desperate times - then the Easter miracle enables us to live our lives in hopeful certainty of the fulfillment of the Resurrection — be it still during our earthly life or at the end of our life's journey.

#### 2<sup>nd</sup> - The empty tomb is the ultimate victory and confirmation of Jesus' message to his friends.

Today with Peter and John and Mary, we stand at the entrance of the empty tomb. Together with Peter and John and Mary, we wonder what it means, this empty tomb. For me the message is clear: Jesus Christ who challenged us to love one another, is risen and walks among us! During his lifetime, Jesus Christ taught compassion, love, forgiveness, reconciliation, sincerity, and selflessness for the sake of others. And this message is certified and affirmed in the Father raising Jesus Christ from the dead. The empty tomb should not only console us and fill us with joy. No, the empty tomb should challenge us to gladly take up the life of the Gospel with its message of compassion, love, forgiveness, reconciliation, sincerity, and selflessness for the sake of others.

## A 3<sup>rd</sup> and last point: The Church is the Resurrection community.

The Risen Christ is present to us in the faithful witness of every good person who shares the good news of the empty tomb. To live the Gospel of selflessness and compassion is difficult if you remain alone. If you belong to a community like the Church, a community like All Saints, living the Gospel of selflessness and compassion is made easier. The empty tomb should inspire us as individuals or as a church community to bring resurrection into this life of ours: to rise above life's sufferings and pain to give love and life to others; to renew and recreate our relationships with others; to proclaim the Gospel of *Christ who died, Christ who has risen; Christ who will come again!* 

Let me summarize: the empty tomb is a reason to hope for us and it is the ultimate victory and confirmation of Jesus' message to his friends. And we need a community to help us to live this friendship with Jesus. With Easter faith, we can awaken the promise of the empty tomb in every place and moment we encounter on our journey through this life – and we can start today, right here in All Saints on this Easter Sunday.
